The trainers will discuss Dan Hughes and Jonathan Baylins (2012) work on Brain-Based parenting. Specifically, how supporting children with complex trauma can impact a parents approach and rewards system and how to work this through in therapeutic context so that parents can build increased security in parent-child relationships. Mirror neurons in relation to attachment will be explored as well as value of self-care and support system to co-regulate these effects. According to Hughes the caregivers state of mind, the ability to sustain caring stance and compassion towards a mistrusting child is key to the process of creating new positive trust experiences for children who have been hurt.
